

ABA, Ethiopia — Preliminary information from the recorder of an Ethiopian airline plane crash that sheared weeks ago shows the crash with an earlier disaster involving the same airline near London, British Foreign Minister said Sunday.

The disclosure about the Ethiopian crash, which killed all 157 people on board, came hours after mourners dressed in black streamed into the vast churchyard of the Holy Trinity Cathedral in the Ethiopian capital, Addis Ababa. Thousands of people marched through the city, accompanying 17 caskets for a funeral. The caskets were empty because author-

ities have said that recovering and identifying the remains will take months.



Mourning in New Zealand

CHRISTCHURCH, New Zealand — A steady stream of mourners paid tribute Sunday at a makeshift memorial to the 50 people slain by a gunman at two mosques in Christchurch.

Hundreds of flowers were piled up amid candles, balloons and notes of grief and love outside the Al Noor mosque. As a light rain fell, people clutched each other and wept quietly.

"We wish we knew your name to write upon your heart. We wish we knew your favorite song, what makes you smile, what makes you cry," read one of the tributes, which contained cutout paper hearts under a nearby tree. "We made a heart for you. 50 hearts for 50 lives."

Two days after Friday's attack, New Zealand's deadliest shooting in modern history, relatives were still waiting for authorities to release the bodies. Islamic law calls for bodies to be cleansed and buried as soon as possible after death, usually within 24 hours.

Supporters arrived from across the country to help with the burials in Christchurch and authorities sent in backhoes to dig graves at a site that was newly fenced off and blocked from view with white netting.



'horrific act of terrorism'

New Zealand Prime Minister Jacinda Ardern said on Monday she would

announce new gun laws within days, after a lone gunman killed 50 people in mass shootings at two mosques in the city of Christchurch.

Australian Brenton Tarrant, 28, a white supremacist, was charged with murder on Saturday. Mr. Tarrant was remanded without a plea and is due back in court on April 5 where police said he was likely to face more charges.

"Within 10 days of this horrific act of terrorism we will have announced reforms which will, I believe, make our community safer," Ms. Ardern told a news conference after her cabinet reached in-principle decisions on gun reform laws in the wake of New Zealand's worst mass shooting. In addition to the 50 killed, dozens were wounded at two mosques in the South Island city

during Friday prayers.

The owner of gun shop Gun City, David Tipple, said the suspected gunman had legally bought four weapons and ammunition online from it between December, 2017, and March, 2018, but it did not sell him the high-powered weapon used in the massacre.

"The MSSA, military-style automatic, reportedly used by the alleged gunman was not purchased from Gun City. Gun City did not sell him an MSSA, only A-category firearms," Mr. Tipple told a news conference.

Under New Zealand gun laws, A-category weapons can be semi-automatic, but limited to seven shots. Livestreamed video of a gunman in one of the mosques showed a semi-automatic weapon with a large magazine.

Mr. Tipple said he supported Ms. Ardern's decision to reform gun laws as the Christchurch shootings had raised legitimate concerns.

Ms. Ardern did not give details on

new laws, but has said she supports a ban on semi-automatic weapons after the Christchurch shootings.

Australia introduced some of the world's toughest gun laws after its worst mass killing, the 1996 Port Arthur massacre in which a lone gunman killed 35 people using a semi-automatic AR-15 – the same weapon used in the Christchurch massacre.

Australia banned semi-automatic weapons, launched a gun amnesty in which tens of thousands of weapons were handed in and made it much tougher to own them.

Ms. Ardern encouraged gun owners who were thinking of surrendering their weapons to do so.

"The clear lesson from history around the world is that to make our community safer, the time to act is now," she said.

"I strongly believe that the vast majority of gun owners in New Zealand will agree with the sentiment that change needs to occur."

Trump homes in on Lordstown

GM, union pressured ahead of expected Ohio visit to salvage plant

President Donald Trump is increasing pressure on General Motors Co. and the United Auto Workers to re-open Lordstown Assembly in Northeast Ohio days before the president is expected to make a campaign stop in the Midwestern swing state.

The president took to Twitter over the weekend and early Monday morning to repeatedly chastise the union and GM over the closure of Lordstown Assembly, which stopped production of the Chevrolet Cruze earlier this month. Lordstown is one of four U.S. plants whose futures will be decided later this year during a re-negotiation of the UAW-GM National Contract.

"General Motors and the UAW are going to start 'talks' in September/October. Why wait, start them now!" Trump tweeted Monday morning. "I want jobs to stay in the U.S.A. and want Lordstown (Ohio), in one of the best economies in our history, opened or sold to a company who will open it up fast!"

The president is scheduled Wednesday to make a re-election campaign stop at the Lima Army Tank Plant in northwestern Ohio.

The UAW's contracts with GM, Ford Motor Co. and Fiat Chrysler Automobiles NV expire on Sept. 14, and bargaining usually ramps up by Labor Day with a formal start to "talks" usually taking place in June






