- . Answer the following questions (60%; 10 points for each question).
 - 1.In discussing the nature of meaning, the notions "intension" and "extension" have been distinguished. Describe the intensions and the extensions of the following two phrases:
 - (a) The President of the United States
 - (b) My best friend
 - 2.Discuss the concept "Maxims of conversation" and use examples to support your discussion.
 - 3. What is the "critical period hypothesis" in language acquisition research? Provide two different sources of evidence in support of the hypothesis.
 - 4. Here are two sets of words from different stages of a child's development.

- (a) Describe the syllable template for the child at each stage. What crucial differences in pronunciations between the early stage and the later stage might account for the change in the pronunciation?
- (b) The words at the early stage show two phonological processes that affect consonants. Describe these processes in words.

 - (a) The towel the maid the gardener liked used was soggy.
 - (b) The gardener liked the maid who used the towel which was soggy. The two sentences are paraphrases of each other, with no significant meaning differences, and neither of them violates any grammatical rule of English. Yet people seldom use the center-embedded sentence (a) because it proves more difficult to process than (b). Why is it more difficult to process sentence (a) than sentence (b)?
- 6. For the following news title, state as precisely as you can in what ways it is ambiguous. Use it as an example to discuss the Principle of Compositionality.
